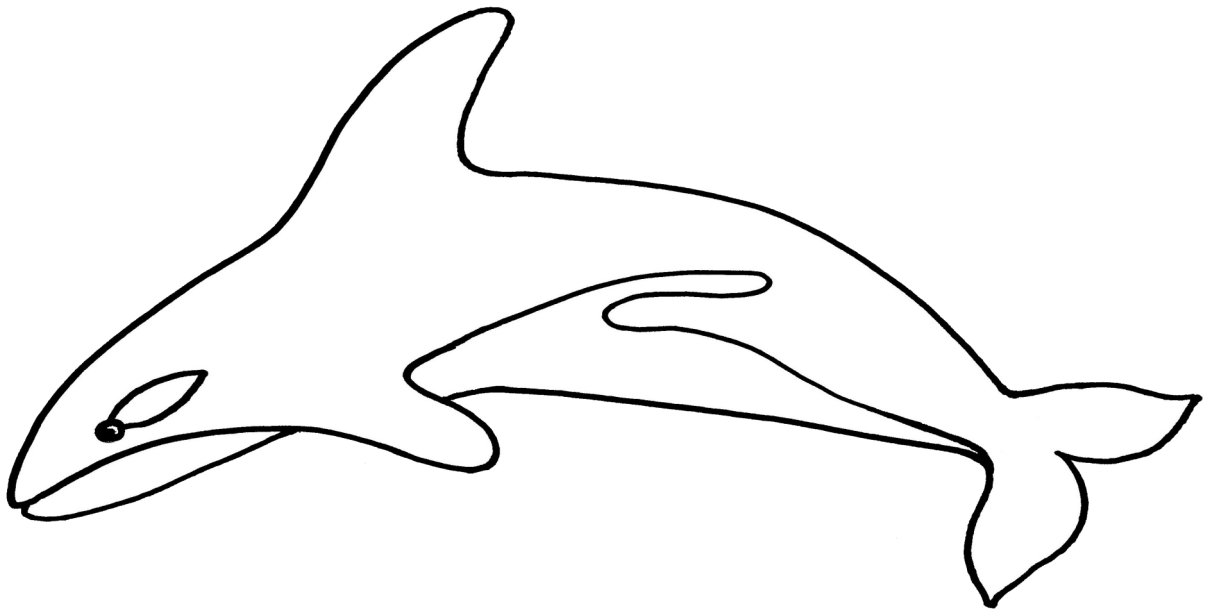

Orca are Mammals.

Orca can make whistle sounds.

Orca travel in oceans in groups called pods which are led by female Orca.

Orca can dive deep under water about 100 meters.

Orca are very good swimmers and can swim up to 29 miles an hour and also are very good jumpers too.

Orca jump out of the water very high.

In cold arctic waters orca hunt seals lying on top of ice floes and they knock the seals off into the sea.

Orca have 45 teeth.

Orca have Black and White skin colour.

Orca have a dorsal fin and 2 pectoral fins, flippers, and one large tail fluke.

Orca do not live in freshwater, they only live in saltwater oceans.

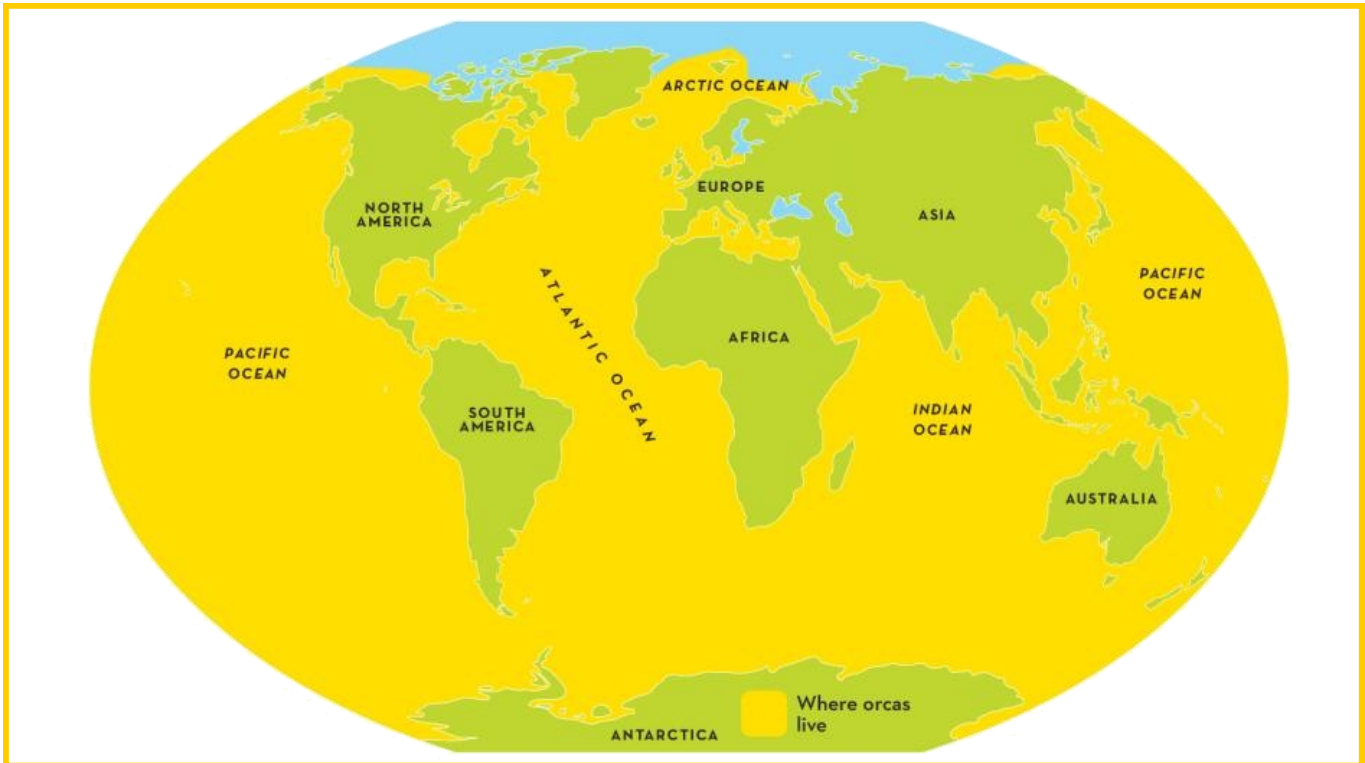
A baby orca is called a calf.

Where do Orca Live?



Orca live in oceans all over the world. Also they can be found in Arctic and Antarctic waters.

What do Orca Eat?

Orca are carnivores. They like to eat Fish, Squid, Penguins, Sea Turtles, Sea Birds, Sharks and Octopuses. Also meat is their main diet.



Hibernation

Orca is warm blooded like other whales. They inhabit all oceans of the world, but are most numerous in the Arctic, the Antarctic, and they like to live in areas of cold water.



All Orca do not hibernate in the winter time.

Life Span

Orca can live up to 50 to 80 years.

Length and Weight

Males Orca can grow up to 6 to 8 Meters.

Orca length about 23 to 32 feet long.

Orca can weigh about 12000 pounds.
