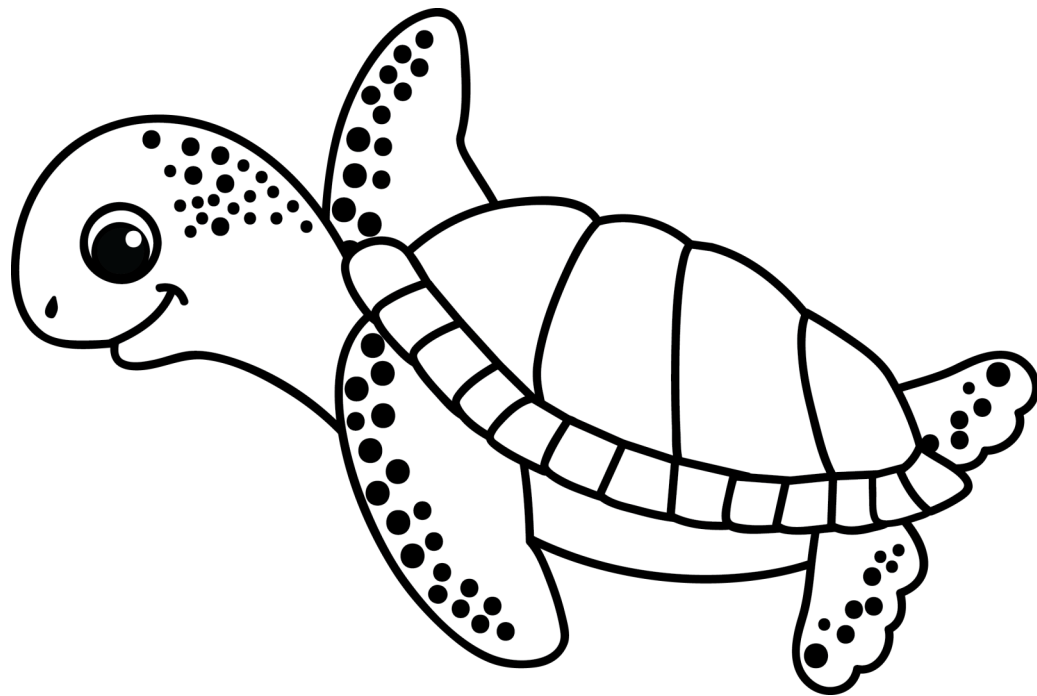

Sea Turtles can dive underwater for about 5-40 minutes.

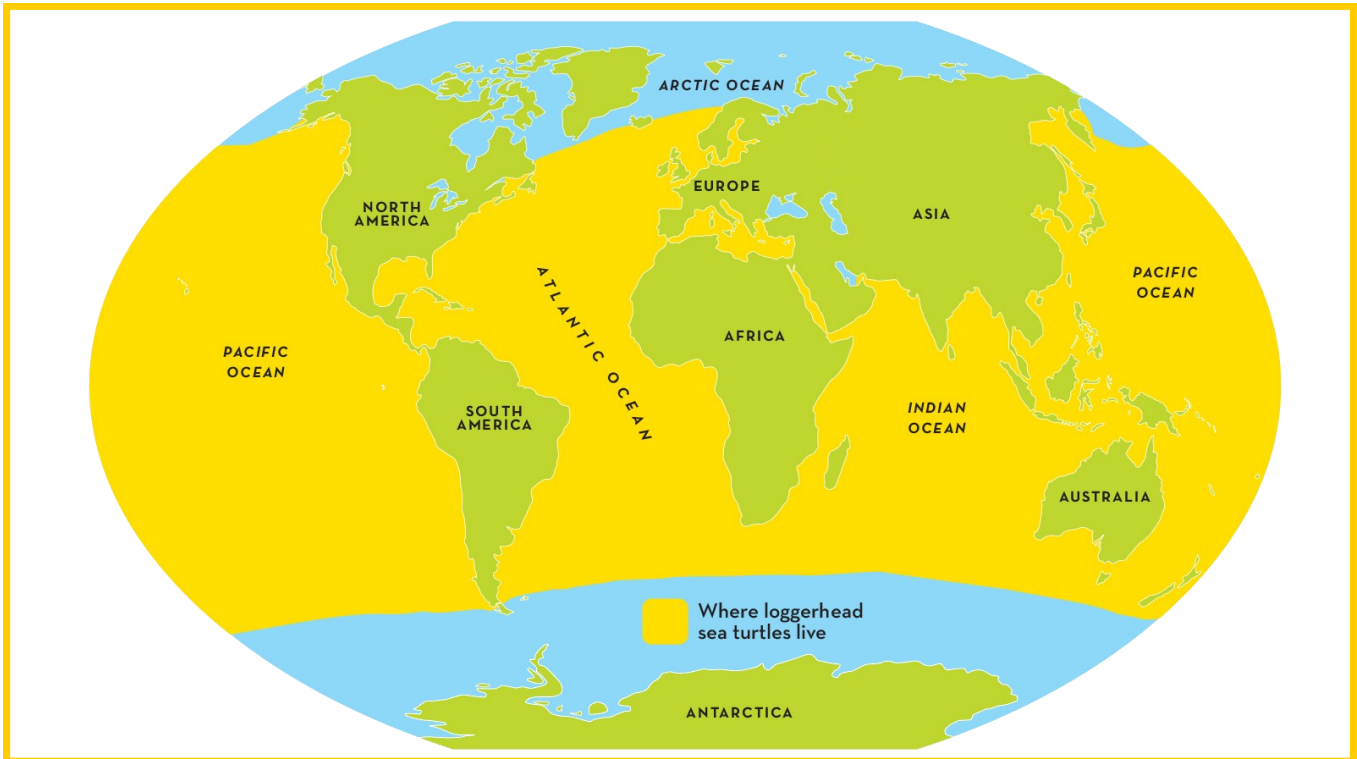
There are so many turtles that have different types of skin and shell colour like green and brown.

Sea Turtles are very good swimmers and also can see underwater.



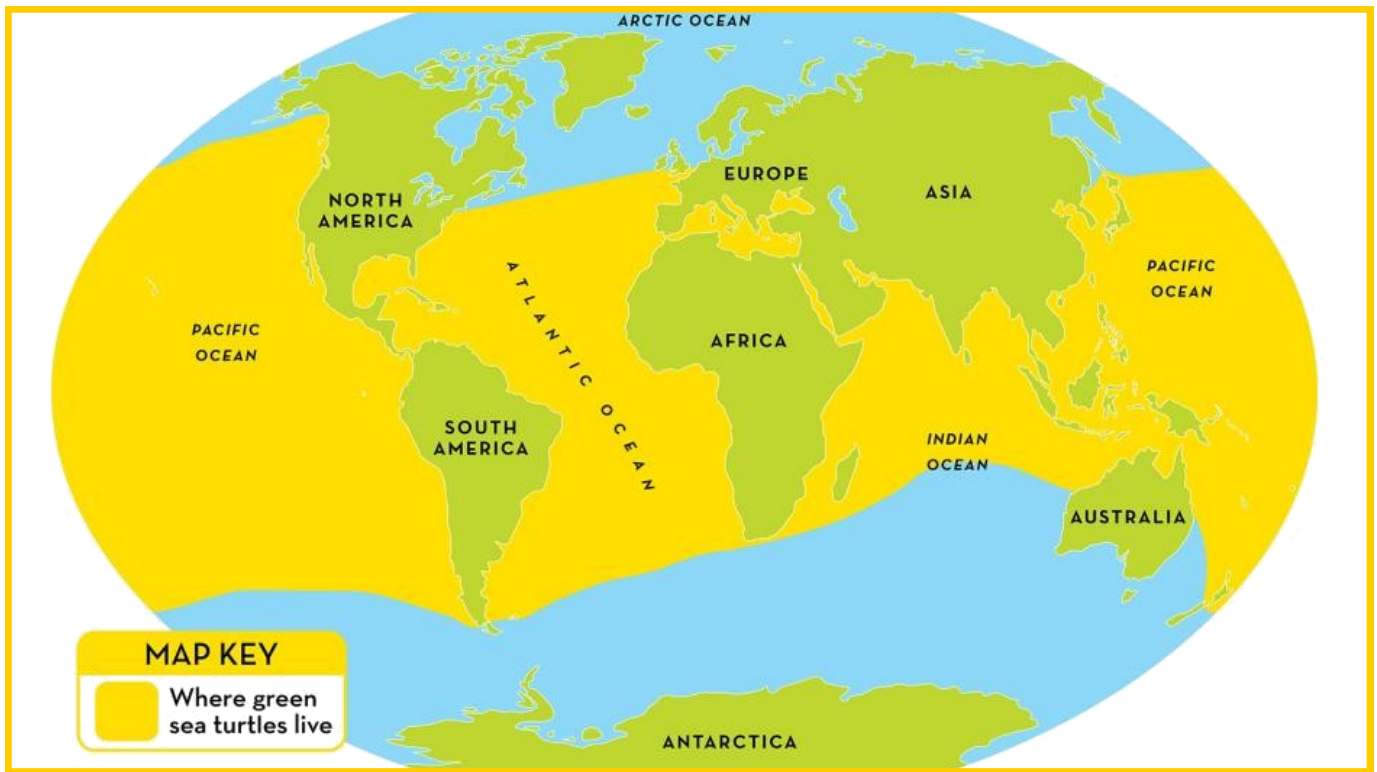
# Where do Sea Turtles Live?



Loggerhead sea turtles live in oceans all over the world and except in the coldest seas. Also Loggerhead turtles can be found near the United States.



Leatherback sea turtles live in the Atlantic, Pacific and Indian oceans.



Green sea turtles live in the Atlantic, Pacific and Indian oceans. Also green sea turtles can be found near Costa Rica and Australia.

## What do Sea Turtles Eat?

Green sea turtles are herbivores. They like to eat seaweed, sea grasses, leaf blades and algae. Also plants are their main diet.





Loggerhead sea turtles are omnivores. They like to eat crabs, sea cucumbers, fish, jellies, molluscs, seaweed, shrimp. Also plants and meat are their main diet.



Leatherback sea turtles are carnivores. They like to eat crabs, horseshoe crabs, fish, jellies, shrimp. Also meat are their main diet.



## Hibernate

Only some types of sea turtles hibernate. When it gets cold, most sea turtles move to warmer oceans. Sea turtles that do hibernate like to dig down into the mud and rest under the mud. When it gets warmer, the turtles come out of the mud and warm themselves, breathe and clean the mud off their bodies.



## Life Span

Sea Turtles can live up to 80 years.

## Length and Weight

Leatherback sea turtle can weigh about 2000 pounds and can be up to 6 feet long.

Green sea turtle can weigh about 3000 to 4000 pounds and can grow up to 3 to 4 feet long.

Loggerhead sea turtle can weigh about 253 pounds and can grow up to 3 feet long.

## More about Sea Turtles

Sea Turtles come out of the water to dig holes in the sand and lay their eggs in the dry sand. The mother turtles lay about 100 to 115 eggs.



Baby Sea Turtles hatch after about 45 to 55 days.
